Dear Enterprise School District Families,

Governor Kate Brown announced a statewide school closure for all schools in Oregon from Monday, March 16th through Tuesday, March 31st. Prior to this announcement, schools were also directed to take actions in an attempt to slow transmission of the COVID-19 virus. What does all this mean for us? Please see the areas below for specific information.

School Dates: Schools are closed effective Monday, March 16th. All staff will return to work Monday, March 30th. Students will return to school Wednesday, April 1st.

Make Up Dates: Students will attend school on the following dates to make up for the school closure. April 2, 3, 10 and 17. Parent conferences will be held from 4-8 pm on April 9th.

Graduation: Graduation remains Saturday, May 23. Seniors' last day remains, May 20.

College Studies Students: Students who are enrolled in college courses and need to continue their studies are welcome to come to the elementary school from 10 am-2 pm, Monday through Friday to have a safe workspace and internet access. We will also help proctor exams if needed.

Meals: We will provide sack lunches for all Enterprise School District students in a "Grab and Go" fashion from 11-12 pm in front of Quinn Court March 16-19 and March 30-31. Ms. Pinkerton and School Counselor Mollie Cudmore will be on site to hand out the lunches and have a brief moment to connect with students and their families.

Athletics: No practices or games until April 1st.

Other School Operations: This is the status until further notice. No assemblies or events that bring community and patrons into buildings. This includes classroom volunteers, field trips, outside professional development, parent meetings, concerts, family nights, etc.

Conferences: Spring conferences will be conducted from via phone or email.

Facility Use: No facility use from community groups, etc. until further notice.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we work together during this challenging time. Please note that this letter is current as of 10:00 am, Monday, March 16th but this situation changes rapidly.
