What is Supplemental Learning?

We are committed to keeping in touch with students and ensuring they stay engaged and have opportunities to learn. It is important to remember that this is NOT normal school. The assignments and activities are intended to review or provide extension activities for material students have covered. We are working to provide materials and work that students can complete with minimal help from adults in the home. Seniors are required to complete and submit their work for graduation.

How will it be received?

Online and in learning packets. Every elementary student will receive access to Study Island for daily interaction with his or her teacher. Secondary students will utilize various online learning resources and paper pencil opportunities as well. We will have staff walking walk routes and riding bus routes to deliver educational/technology items to students. We will send out information on when/where to meet us to pick up your items.

What if students need help?

Teachers and our Counselor are just a phone call away. All teachers and school counselor will be available via phone and email from 8 am-3 pm, Monday-Thursday. Your child's teacher will provide you with their contact information.

What if we need supplies?

We are delivering Ipads/Chromebooks and learning materials. We recognize that many students are sharing devices or do not have devices. We will check out a Chromebook to each child and deliver it to you! We are also delivering supplies left in elementary students' desks to their homes so they have those materials at home during this time too.

What about Wi-Fi?

The City of Enterprise has internet at the library. We have limited number of hot spots we can check out to families who do not have internet access.
